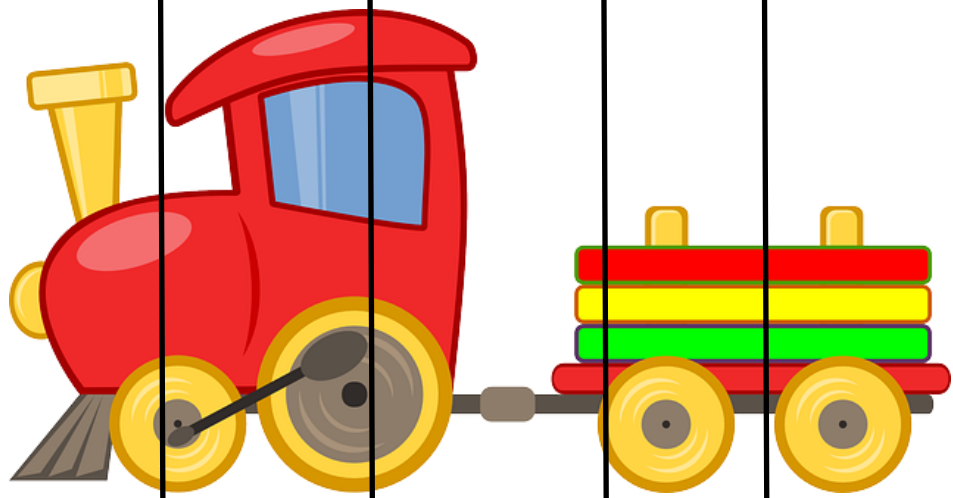




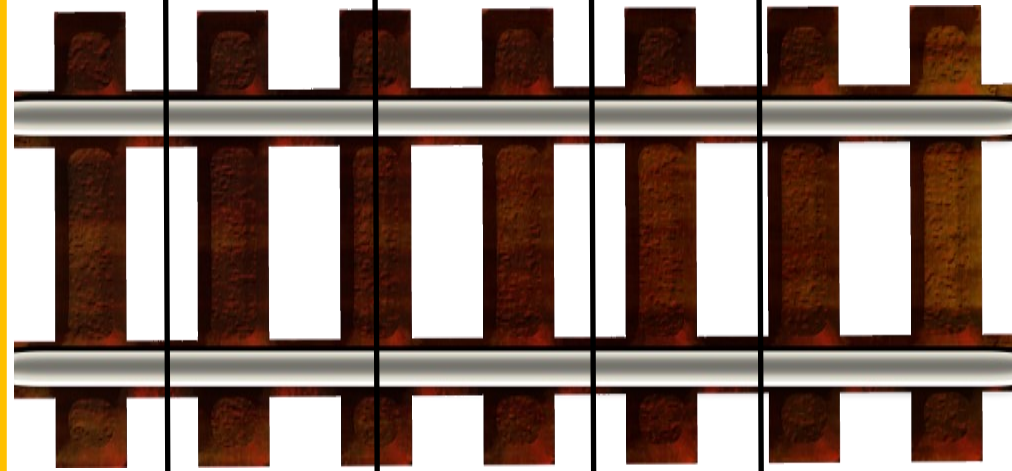
# Railroad Word Assembly

- See how many times you can put the words back into the right order

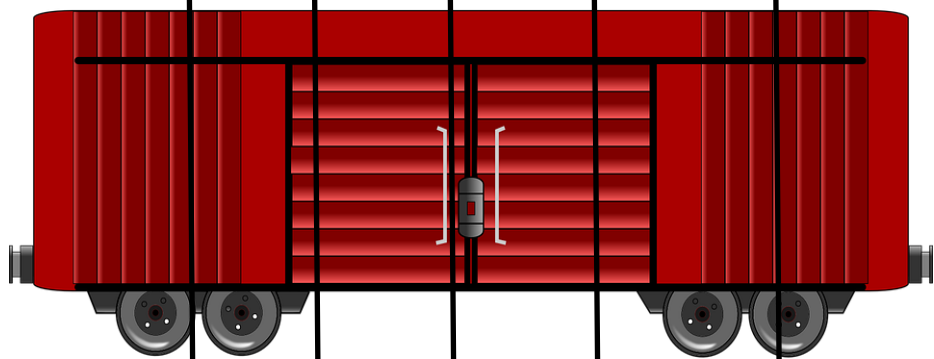




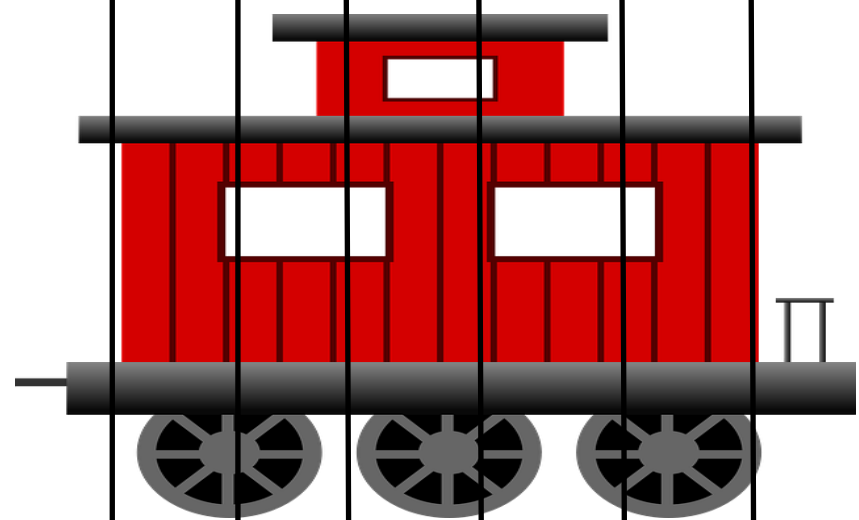

## *West Virginians: Then and Now!*



Transportation starting in the 1800s experienced a major change. Before and in the early 1800s people used primarily horses and carts to travel and move goods. Then in 1802 trains were invented. Trains were powered by steam and were able to connect people from different states and across the United States. The Baltimore and Ohio Railroad ran across 13 states. The railroad came to Martinsburg, West Virginia later on in 1840s.

Transportation experienced even more changes in the twentieth century! There were more ways for people to move around. Cars became popular and people owned their own cars, especially in the 1950s. Passenger air planes started to be used, allowing people to easily travel across the country and the world! Track trailers were used to move goods across the country. People and companies used less trains.
